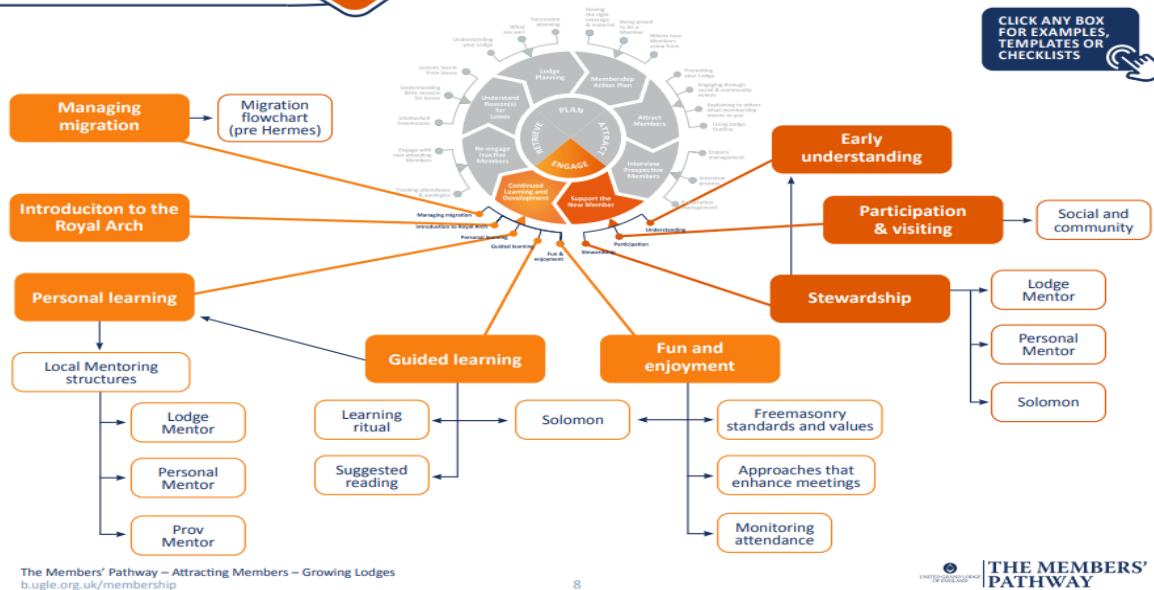




Members' Pathway: Introducing Access Keys To Aid Navigation

AI comes to Solomon
